

Scripture Songs #1 - March 1994

Close the Door

"But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly." Matthew 6:6

There is a secret place when the door is shut. This is not secret and shameful. It is secret and glorious. When you go to the secret place, you enable Father 's eyes to see you. He cannot see you if you never come to this place. He sees in secret.
